



2009 FISHING COMPETITION RULES

28 / 29 / 30 AUGUST

1. Official start 4:00pm Friday 28th August, 2009.
2. Entry fee \$25.00 (club members) or \$31.00 for Club Membership if not already a financial member. Entry fee is only paid once, you may fish for 1 or 3 days. Identification must be presented at weigh-in. **Entry fee must be paid before 12pm on Saturday 29th August, to be eligible to weigh-in a fish.**
3. All fish must be weighed on official scales provided by Club to be eligible.
4. All fish presented must be taken on rod and reel or hand line.
5. No undersized fish will be weighed-in.
6. Weigh-in will be on Sunday, 30th August, from 12noon and contestants must be in the line at 1pm.
7. All fish being weighed-in need to be gutted and gilled. No whole fish will be weighed-in.
8. Any fish deemed not edible will not be weighed-in, in the opinion of the official judges will be disqualified – THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.
9. In order to win a prize, the fish must be in the category nominated.
10. One fish can win one major prize and only one fish per category per person can be weighed-in.
11. Should there be a tie for first place, the first fish weighed in will be deemed the winner.
12. Any Category where a fish is not weighed in, the prize money will be drawn from the barrel in 3 draws x \$100.
13. All boats are to comply with Queensland Boating Regulations. All prizes must be claimed on Sunday. Winner of lucky entry prize must be present at the draw.
14. The competitors note that the BEERWAH RSL & CITIZENS MEMORIAL CLUB Inc. accepts no liability for injury, loss or damage of any person during the competition. Whether such injury or loss is due to any act, neglect or default of the BEERWAH RSL & CITIZENS MEMORIAL CLUB Inc. or of any official or agent there of and all competitors fully understand that in so participating, they do so entirely at their own risk.
15. JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL- reference book is E.N. GRANT'S GUIDE TO FISHING 1985 Edition.
16. The Management shall have the absolute right to exclude anyone from the competition.
17. **All winning Fish will remain the property of the Competition.**

1. To be eligible for the draw you must have paid entry fee.
2. The entrant possessing the number announced must present him/herself with fishing comp I.D & Photographic I.D within one minute of the draw or another draw will occur.
3. Any action, incident or situation not covered by these rules and conditions written in this brochure, shall be determined co-jointly by the organizing committee of the BEERWAH RSL & CITIZENS CLUB Inc, and the Official Judge if or when those conditions arise. Their decision is final.
